Thank you for your overwhelming support of our Vehicle Registration Program. We have received 95% of the forms identifying vehicles residing on Willowmere property.

Please be reminded that residents must park their vehicles either in their garage, or in their assigned parking space. Guest spaces are for guests visiting Willowmere. We understand that sometimes guest spaces are utilized for a short duration (15 minutes or less), to unload groceries, or heavy goods from the vehicle, but we must ask that you not leave your car parked in a guest spot afterwards.

Vehicle Registration (continued)

Please do not park your cars overnight in common areas, or against the curb. Remember that emergency vehicles need to have access when necessary. If you have guests visiting, or contractors working on-site, please ensure our parking rules are communicated and that trailers and/or trucks are not left overnight on the property.

Landscape / Watershed Notes

We completed the annual residential inspection on June 3rd. Areas of non-compliance were identified, and residents will receive notices if there is an item that requires attention. In addition, each spring and fall we perform a community walk with our landscape and tree contractors to identify and prioritize special work needed in common areas. Some of these projects are noted by members of the community, and many others are identified by our committee from routine site observations that include our woods, pond, and stream. For this summer and early fall, we have approximately 30 projects ranging in size. Among them are turf restoration, tree and shrub removal/replacement (native species), brick walkway repairs (including tripping hazards), new bench installation, and front entrance flowers. Some of these projects have been completed or are underway. These are all focused on beautification and enhancement of our environment and most are additional to the normal contract work (e.g., front gate plantings, lawncare, debris pick up, mulching).

Exterior Home Projects

As you plan your summer and fall projects, please remember that an approved request for any exterior work must be provided to CPM, before work can start. The form can be found on our website, or by contacting Carol Oliveira. We recommend homeowners remain present when there is a contractor working on an external project in case there are questions, or in the event there is damage to common spaces. Please also remember to notify your neighbors, as a courtesy.
